## Axiom SL User Group Meeting in London

**London, March 9, 2011** - Following Axiom's successful user's meeting at Goldman Sachs in New York last June, Axiom SL gathered customers in London for its user's group meeting hosted by Morgan Stanley. Presentations by senior representatives from Axiom SL and Morgan Stanley addressed upcoming CoREP reporting within Europe, Basel III implications, the challenges of implementation, a case study on Morgan Stanley's liquidity implementation and a demo of Axiom's latest version new features.

Aditya Gupta, Finance IT at Morgan Stanley, detailed the bank's selection and liquidity implementation process.

With over 40 data sources, Morgan Stanley were looking for an enterprise-wide reporting tool that had a flexible data model a solution that could be easily integrated into their current systems environment. Having completed a market evaluation covering 8 different vendors, Axiom was found to have the leading solution in the areas of: 1) Data model flexibility 2) Audit and Analysis 3) User-friendly business rules configuration 4) Ad-hoc reporting; and 5) Ease of installation.

Morgan Stanley had to face steep deadlines after vendor selection, but starting in May 2010 they managed to enter User Acceptance Testing by July, for live reporting of their FSA liquidity returns in September 2010.

A year on, and they have now implemented Bank of England reporting which runs millions of records through the system every day, and are looking to use Axiom for as many things as possible; recognising that Controller View™ is more than just a reporting tool.

In view of new upcoming regulations, Axiom's approach to requirements such as CoREP and Basel III was discussed. The meeting concluded with presentation of new features including the Basel 123™ computational module and the new WEB-Based report writer to the users' audience which included the likes of Morgan Stanley, JP Morgan Chase, Credit Suisse, RBS, Goldman Sachs and UBS.
